KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I. R. H. Bramlett

Eight Hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by D. M. Bramlett

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

D. M. Bramlett, all that tract and parcel of land, situate and being in the County of Greenville, and the State aforesaid in Austin Township, bounded by lands of D. W. Holland, W. F. Verdin, J. F. Watson, Dr. W. H. Austin and J. C. Burdett, containing one hundred acres more or less.

Beginning at a corner near Gilders Creek on J. F. Watson's line running thence S. 25° E. 13.90 to a white oak near a spring, thence S. 28° W. 27.10 to a stake or red oak on W. F. Verdin's line thence S. 27 W. 13.18 to a pine on D. W. Holland's line thence S. 53 E. 29 to a pine near the Road in front of D. W. Holland's House, thence to said Road and along the same towards and to Bethel Church thence to a rock corner on D. W. Holland's line, thence to the beginning corner near Gilders Creek, it being the same tract of land conveyed to R. H. Bramlett on the 29th day of May 1886 by Elizabeth Bramlett.
