Herdin, all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township Greenville County and State of South Carolina, containing 70 acres more or less adjoining lands of Lola Forest, J. S. Hamby, J. T. Jones and Boyce Miller and being all of a tract of 4.5 acres described in Deed of C. S. Hamby to J. T. Hamby, dated May 30, 1878 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County (Dec. 17, 1919) in Deed Book, Vol. 60, page 2, and is a part of a tract of 102 acres conveyed to J. T. Hamby by C. S. Hamby on November 19, 1854 and recorded in R. M.
