Twenty-one (21) feet to a drill hole on the sidewalk, thence N. 69° 30' W. one hundred (100) feet with line of lot No. 10 of said plat to an iron pin on an Alley; thence with said alley N. 28° 55' E. twenty-one (21) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69° 30' E. one hundred (100) feet with line of lot No. 8 to the beginning corner, and known as lot No. 9 on the plat made by J.
