H. H. Birmingham, all that certain piece of land situate  
lying and being in Ward Two, of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville  
and State aforesaid on Park Avenue, did having the following metes and  
bounds to wit: According to a survey made by R. C. Dalton, June, 1919.commencing at an iron pipe at the N.E. corner of Trickle and Bennett  
Street, thence along the north side of Park Ave. S. 63° 01' E. 105.1 feet to  
an iron pipe; thence N. 47° 50' E. one hundred, eighty-four and  
five tenths (184.5) feet to a pipe; thence along property of W. C. Cleve-  
land N. 63° 01' W. two hundred and three tenths (203.3) feet to an  
iron pipe on the east side of Bennett Street; thence along the cur-
