between Greenville and Spartanburg, about 1/4 mile from
Greenville Court House, containing Sevev ($\frac{1}{4}$) acres more or
less, and being a part of a fifteen (15) acre tract of land
bought by one *Frank M. R. Garrett*, December 7, 1886, by deed
recorded in the R.M.C. office in said State and said
County in Vol. 57 page 247 and more particularly described
as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the
aforesaid 15 acre tract, joint corner Locke, Edwards, and
Tanner, and running thence with Edwards line N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.
58 4.4 feet to a stone; thence N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1 foot with R.F. Watson's line,
(formerly Smith's) to a point distant 186 feet from the center of the
Southbound track of said Southern Railway, thence in a westerly
