(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

E. B. Smith, all that certain piece of land
just outside and North of the City of Greenville, known as
the west half of lot no. 2, subdivision of the Brust
property, known as Oakland, plat made by W. J. Neves,
on June 1st, 1911, and having the following metes and
bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Brust
Avenue 200 feet from the corner of Rutherford Street
(known as the Camp Road) and Brust Avenue, and
running thence S 64-30 E. 50 feet to an iron stake,
being the center of lot no. 12 as stated above; thence
North 28-15-E. 89 feet 6 inches to an iron pin; thence
in a line parallel with Brust Ave., 50 feet to the
corner of lot 2 and 3 to iron pin; thence 187 feet
6 inches to the beginning corners, and being one half
of the same lot conveyed to us by W. Warren Chapman, by
