all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

one what is known as the Black Sprague Road and having, according to a survey made by R. C. Dalton in May 1919, the following width and boundaries: commencing at a stone on the south side of said Black Sprague road, formerly known as the old Rutherford Road, corner of Stone property, thence along the south side of said road N. 58-30 E. 174 feet to a nail iron pin; thence N. 24-20 E. 406 feet crossing a branch to a stone about 30 feet, more or less, below a sprig; thence up a branch, passing through said sprig, N. 4-28 W. 433.2 feet to a stone on south side of said Black Sprague Road; thence along south side of said road N. 176-01 E. 196 feet to a stake; thence N. 88-51 E. 496 feet along other property of J. D. Bridger to a stake; thence N. 10-51 W. 231 feet, passing through electric light pole No 109, to a stake on the south side of said road; thence along south side of said road as follows: 8-73-03 N. 44-49-3 feet to a bend; 8-70-44 N. 258.8 feet to bend; 8-61-15 N. 274 feet to a stake on south side of said road and the line of Stone property thence with line of Stone property N. 121-50 W. 59 feet to the beginning and containing 2.82 acres more or less. Also a strip of land containing 0.26 acres, more or less, being one-half of the Black Sprague Road, which is 30 feet wide, immediately abutting and adjoining the above described land and extending along the entire length thereof, it being our intention that J. D. Bridger's title shall extend to the center of said road as it is now.

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
