all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the east side of Augusta Street and south side of University Street, beginning at corner of Williams lot on Augusta Street and running thence west Augusta Street N. 31 E. 138 $\frac{1}{4}$ feet corner of University Street, and thence west University Street S. 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 331 feet thence S. 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 100 feet to line of the Williams lot; thence west the Williams lot N. 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. about 330 feet to the beginning corner; these measurements are adopted from the deed made by Elizabeth M. Axson to John C. Bailey which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in deed book A.A. page 87, where said John C. Bailey conveyed by two separate deeds the greater part of the land to the said Laura G. Bailey, and it was the intention of the said John C. Bailey to convey all of the said lot to the said Laura G. Bailey, but as there is some doubt as to whether the two deeds included all of said lot this deed is made by us sole to vest the complete title to all of said land in the said Laura G. Bailey.
