in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said A. F. Day, his heirs and assigns forever.

I all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, City of Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
All that certain lot of land situate on the East side of Green Avenue, in the City of Greenville, S.C. Beginning at an iron pin on Green Avenue, corner of lot of Beverley Farrow and runs thence $827\frac{1}{2}$ N. 367 feet and 6 inches, more or less, to an iron pin in head of said Avenue, thence with said Avenue $820\frac{1}{2}$ E. 213 feet blushed, more or less to a stake on right of way of S. G. Railway, thence with said right of way N. E. 392 feet and 4 inches more or less, to a stake, thence N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 127 feet and 4 inches, more or less, to peach tree stumps, now iron pin, thence N. 16 E. 150 feet and 6 inches more or less, to iron pin, thence N. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 109 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner on Greene Avenue, same being known as Lot Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, as shown on a plat recorded in Plat Book "C" page 6 and being the same land conveyed to me by J. As part of the consideration of this conveyance, the grantee herein does hereby assume and agree to pay a certain note and mortgage executed by W. D. Workman and Walter W. Goldsmith to A. Louise Heyward for \$2667⁰⁰ dated July 15 1920, recorded in Vol. 803 page 27 together with interest thereon at the rate of 7 per cent per annum from January 15th 1921.

do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. F. Day, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
