all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

About three miles west of the City of Greenville, Beginning at a corner post on the south side of a new road (which joins the New Cut Road at the Miller place, now owned by Prof. J. G. Poole) and runs thence along said road N. 57.10° 26.1330 feet; thence N. 19.45° 24.682 feet; thence S. 71.30° 150 feet to a stone; thence 49.30° 24.95 feet to a stake in Long Branch; thence down the meanders of said branch 22.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 19.15° 6.660 feet to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to me by W. C. Coyle, by Deed dated the 31st day of December, 1919, and recorded in Vol. 63, page 132.

Also all those two certain lots of land nos. 10 and 11 of the Subdivision of the J. H. Ellison land, situate best of, and near, the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid. Beginning on the south west side of a proposed public road and at a point on said road 40.94 feet from where said road cuts off the Circle land, on the south east and runs thence S. 19.05° 26.740 feet; thence N. 73° 26.720 feet; thence N. 30.15° E. 1.056 feet to said proposed public road; thence S. 49.20° E. along said proposed road 56.5 feet to the beginning corner, Lot no. 10 containing 8.1 acres and lot 2d. 11.5 acres, being the same land conveyed to me by Maude C.
