all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Situate, lying and being on the north side of Spartanburg Road and having the following metes and bounds according to plat made by Furness & Curran, Engineers dated August 21st 1920 to-wit: Beginning at the corner of a thirty-foot street running from the Spartanburg Road and on the north side of Spartanburg road and on the west side of said street at the intersection of said road and said street and running thence with said street northwesterly 200 feet to a fifteen foot alley thence with said alley S. 68° 0' W. 60 feet to corner of lot no. 5, thence parallel with said thirty foot street south-easterly 200 feet to a point on the north side of said Spartanburg Road, corner of lot no. 5, thence with Spartanburg Road N. 68° E. 60 feet to the beginning corner and being lot no. 6 of a sub-division of land which was formerly known as the John Thompson property conveyed to Annie D.
