in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release,
unto the said Jones McCrory, his heirs and assigns
forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Carlton, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

and being more specifically described upon a plat of the lands
of Howard Caldwell, made by P. E. Walton, Engr. September, 1920,
and having the following metes and bounds according to said
plat, to-wit:—Beginning at a stone on the Pelham-Greenville
Road, and running thence along said road, as follows:—N.
44° 05' W. 265 feet to a stake, thence N. 44° 05' W. 650 feet to stake,
thence N. 44° 05' W. 288 feet to stake, thence leaving said Pelham-
Greenville Road, and running S. 40° 30' W. 256 feet to stake, thence
N. 49° 30' W. 11 feet to stake, thence along lands of C. R. Watson S. 40° 30'
W. 153 1/2 feet to stone, thence S. 40° 30' W. 290 feet to stake, thence
S. 40° 30' W. 102 1/2 feet to stake on creek; thence with the meanders of
said creek as a line to a stake; thence leaving said creek and run-
ning S. 40° 30' W. 102 1/2 feet to stake; thence S. 40° 30' E. 234 feet to a stake, thence
S. 40° 30' E. 390 feet to stone; thence S. 40° 30' E. 69.7 feet to a stump; thence
N. 40° 30' E. 390 feet to stone; thence S. 40° 30' E. 147.6 feet to a stone, the beginning
30 W. 350 feet to a stake; thence S. 40° 30' W. 147.6 feet to a stone, the beginning
corner. This being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Mary P. Kilgore,
by her deed dated January 2nd, 1920, and recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville
County, in Vol. 48, page 107, and containing one hundred and thirty-five and 3/4 acres
(135.35) acres, more or less.

Possession of the aforesaid premises is to be given immediately unto the
grantee herein, and he, the said grantee, is to have the rents and profits for said
lands for the entire year, 1921, but he, the said grantee, is to carry out the
terms and conditions of the contracts previously entered into between the
grantor herein and various tenants now cultivating the aforesaid lands.
The grantor herein has already advanced to the said tenants certain mon-
ies and has agreed to be responsible for the fertilizer being used by said
tenants; and has also agreed to advance to said tenants such other sum
as may be necessary for them to have in making said crops for
the present year, and the grantor herein has taken for himself contracts
and certain chattel mortgages to secure his rent, and also to secure his advan-
cements; and the grantee herein is to have said contracts and rents and mortgages
herein assigned unto himself and is to pay over to the grantor such sum or sums
of money as may be already advanced by him unto the said tenants together
with interest on said sum or sums, and the taxes upon the said premises for the
year 1921 are to be paid by the grantee.

It is understood and agreed, and made a part of the consideration for
this conveyance, that the said Jones McCrory is to assume and pay a certain
note and mortgage, given by Howard Caldwell to J. S. Kilgore Jr. in the
sum of twelve thousand four hundred (\$12,400.00) dollars, said assumption
being to pay said note and mortgage according to the terms and
conditions thereof, which said mortgage is recorded in the P. M. C.
Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 8, page 194. It being understood
that the interest upon this obligation has been paid up to the 8th
day of January, 1921, and from that said date, the grantee herein assumes
the payment of interest as well as the principal.
