the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. W. Brothers, Jr. the following described real estate, to wit: "All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the Piedmont or Grove Road, being lot number four (4) of South Cherokee Park, a subdivision of land represented by a plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 130. Said lot has a frontage of 60 feet on Piedmont Road and running back a depth of 172 feet to an alley, and has the following metes and bounds: Beginning at corner of lot 5 on Piedmont Road and running thence S. 63 E. 172 feet joint line of lots 4 and 5 to an alley, thence with said alley S. 37 W. 60 feet to corner of lot 3; thence with joint line of lots 3 and 4, N. 63 W. 172 feet to Piedmont Road; thence with Piedmont Road N. 27 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, and being a portion of same land conveyed to said Cherokee Land Company by H.
