That the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and no/100 Dollars to him in hand paid this day (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) and the further consideration of Eleven Hundred and Ninety Dollars to be paid by the party of the second part in eleven annual installments of \$100.00 each, except first payment which is to be \$90.00, beginning on the 31st, day of December 1918, with interest on the unpaid belance at the rate of eight per cent per annum to be paid annually on December 31st, of each year; and the further consideration on the part of the party of the second part's undetaking to build on the lot hereinafter described a house to consist of not less than four rooms, said house to be built complete before January 1st, 1918, the party of the first part does hereby lease unto the party of the second part all that piece parcel and lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid on the White Horse Road, near Welcome Church, containing Twelve acres, more or less, and known as tract No. 16 on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. office for said Greenville County in Plat Book A., page 165, bounded by lands of Mrs. Camilla Looper, Mrs. Mabel C.
