(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Ethel B. Davis her heirs and assigns, all that  
lot of land situate in the city and County of  
Greenville South Carolina, on the East side of  
South Main street, between Broad and Murphy  
streets, Beginning at a corner on the East side  
of South Main Street, and runs thence S. 94° E.  
176<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> feet, to a corner; thence S. 16° W. 21<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> feet to a  
corner; thence N. 94° W. 176<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> feet to corner on Main  
Street; thence with said street N. 16° E. 21<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> feet  
to the beginning corner, being the same land  
conveyed to me by Thos. S. Mauldin and Oscar  
A. Mauldin, by deed dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of January  
1920, and recorded in Vol. 55, Page 164.  
Also all my right title and interest in the wall  
dividing the lot herein conveyed from the adjoining  
lot on the South side which is expressed in the  
deed from P. J. Bowles and W. M. Miller (recorded  
in Vol. 24, Page 384) in part as follows: With the  
privilege of tiling on to said wall any building  
which may be erected by the grantee herein, or  
any claiming under them. Also the right and  
privilege unto the grantee herein, her tenants and  
assigns, of using the stairway extending from  
Main Street to the second story of the building  
on the said adjoining lot with the right to cut  
and maintain a door way of such width and  
height as may be self determined upon by the  
grantee herein, or those claiming under them,  
through the side wall so as to connect any  
building which may be erected on the lot  
herein granted with the building at the top  
of said stairway, this right and privilege to exist  
as long as the building of grantor herein remains  
as it now is, until taken down or destroyed.  
As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the  
grantee herein does hereby assume & will pay a certain note  
and mortgage, dated Sept. 21, 1919, executed by W. D. Workman and  
W. R. Watkins to W. D. Dodge & W. A. Floyd for \$6,612.50, together with  
interest from the date of this conveyance at the rate of 7% per  
annum, until paid which mortgage is expressly excepted from the  
general warranty herein after expressed. Also that other mortgage  
given by me to C. J. T. T. Mauldin, 13<sup>th</sup> Jan 1920, recorded in  
Vol. 81, Page 152, for \$13,875.00, with interest thereon from the date  
at the rate of 7% per annum, in accordance with the  
terms of same.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Ethel B. Davis, her  
heirs and assigns, forever.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Ethel B. Davis

her heirs and assigns, against

my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
