(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Frances H. Cushman all that lot or parcel of land, situated in Ward Five City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, on the West side of Leach Street, south side of Leach Street and East side of Bond Street, beginning at the corner of Morris and Leach Streets, and running thence with Morris Street 31 feet 30 inches 251 feet to a point in Leach Street where Morris and Leach Streets meet S. 30° 30' W. 113° 30' 8 inches, a distance of 34 feet, thence S. 59° 30' E. 232 feet to corner of Leach Street 31 feet 30' 8 inches to the beginning corner in Leach and Morris Streets.

This conveyance includes a proposed Street of 34 feet running from Morris Street to Bond Street west to the Morris Line, but there is no obligation on the part of the grantee to open said Street - Excepted from this conveyance, however, is Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7 of property above described, according to plan of the Land Survey of H. H. Rogers and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville, October 26, 1916, page 115.

This conveyance includes all the remaining said lot shown on said plan - This being the same plan conveyed to me by H. H. Rogers by deed dated April 14th 1917, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County on Oct. 30, page 239.

I, the undersigned, do attest that what is known as the Spring lot, included in this area in lot No. 15 according to said plan, is not warranted unto the grantee herein, being of small size of land intersecting the Spring on the corner of said property, there being a quantity of land left to said small portion. Said Spring lot is supposed to be 50 feet square at the northwest corner of lot No. 15, on Morris Street.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Frances H. Cushman, her
