(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. P. Able the sum aforesaid,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being on the East side of Green Avenue within the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following written and bounded, corner and distance as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on Green Avenue corner of Lot of Beverly Garrison, and running thence S. 71° 36' feet and six inches more or less to iron pin in bend of said Green Avenue; thence continuing with Green S. 20° 34' E. 213 feet and six inches, more or less, to a stake on right of way of Central S. Railroad; thence with said right of way N. E. 39° and 4 inches, more or less, to a stake; thence N. 70° 34' W. 134 feet and 4 inches more or less, to peach tree stump; more iron pin; thence S. 16° E. 150 feet and 6 inches, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 86° 34' W. 109 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner on Green Avenue and designated as lot No. 123, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, are shown on plat recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" page 6 and being the same property conveyed to W. D. Markman and Walter T. Goldsmith by A. Louise Heyward by deed dated June 15th, 1920 and recorded in R. M. C. for said County in Vol. 66 page 249.

Walter T. Goldsmith having conveyed his one undivided one-half interest to W. D. Markman by deed dated June 5, 1920, recorded in R. M. C. in Vol. 68, page 191, by accepting and receiving, however, a ten foot strip fronting on Green Ave which I have given bond for title to Beverly Garrison, and more fully shown on plat made by Furman and Curzon, hereto attached.

It is understood and agreed that the entire lot as aforesaid to me by A. Louise Heyward, excepting the ten foot strip hereinabove referred to is hereby conveyed, but the grantee warrants said property only to such right of way as the said Central S. Railroad may possess.

As a part of the consideration hereinabove expressed the grantor herein J. P. Able, expressly assumes and promises to pay a certain note and mortgage executed by W. D. Markman and Walter T. Goldsmith to A. Louise Heyward in the sum of \$2667, together with interest at seven per cent from July 15, 1920 until paid, said mortgage being recorded in R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 83 p. 26.

J. P. Able is to pay all state and county taxes for 1920.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. P. Able, his
