certain pieces, parcels or lots of land, situate by me
and being in the State of South Carolina, and County
and Township of Greenville, about 1½ miles North of the
City of Greenville, in the village of Oakwood; First lot
described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin or
iron southwest side of Pierce Street at corner of lot
described as follows to P. M. Hampton by deed recorded
in book 25 page 147, and running thence with line of
lot lot 247-3-41, one hundred eighty-three feet to an
iron pin on a 14 foot alley, thence North said alley 8.
41-30-6-51 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 48-30-6-183 feet
to an iron pin on Pierce Street and thence South
said street N. 41-30-6-50 feet to the beginning corner
being a portion of lot 75 and 76 as above set
forth recorded in Plat book A, page 424, this being
