Harrison his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Greenville Township, on the northeast side of Bunccombe Road, and being lot 520.3 on plat made by W.A. Adams Jan. 20th, 1905, and having the following corneres and bounds: as shown by said plat recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County. Beginning at the corner of lot 520.2 on the Bunccombe Road, and running thence with line of said lot 57.59^{1/4} E. 225 feet to corner wth Williams Street; thence with said Williams Street ac the line S. 21° 20' E. 70 feet to corner of lot 520.4; thence with line of said lot 520.4 8.59^{1/4} N. 225 feet to Bunccombe Road; thence with Bunccombe N. 21° 20' 70 feet to the beginning corner and bounded on the North by lot No. 2 on the West by Bunccombe Road, on the South by lot 520.4, and on the East by Williams Street, and being the same lot conveyed to me by B.M.
