Kirkpatrick, his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain tract of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, near Easleyville: Beginning at an iron pin in center of public road and running thence down the center of said road N. 22° 7' 41 feet to a pin, thence N. 78° W. 2970 feet to corner on Little Rock Creek, thence up the meanders of said creek to state in line of tract No. 6, thence S. 77° E. 1805 7/8 feet to a rock, thence S. 66° 40' E. 1110 to the beginning corner, containing 45 1/2 acres more or less, and being tract No. 5, according to plan recorded in Plat book E, page 162, R.R.C. Office for Greenville County. This is the same land conveyed to me by Coke Smith by deed dated February 17th, 1920, recorded in said R.R.C. Office in Book 5, page 119. As a part of the consideration for said conveyance herein the said J.W.
