Cobb, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Mulberry Street and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Mulberry Street 153 1/4 feet from the corner of Pinckney and Mulberry Streets and running with Mulberry Street N. 61° 1' E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 32 E. 131 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57 W. 40 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 37 W. 134 feet to the beginning corner.
