Barton, All that certain lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, just south of Hampton Avenue extension and west of Kelly Avenue, or Bramlett Road, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the southwest corner of lot of E.O. Couch, which iron pin is one hundred and fifty (150) feet from southern side of Hampton Avenue and running thence S. 18°45' W. 181 feet to a stake; thence S. 81°15' E. 261 feet to stake; thence N. 10°25' E. 75 feet, more or less, to stake; thence N. 81°15' W. 30 feet to stake; thence N. 10°25' E. approximately 69 feet to stake; thence N. 74°00' W. approximately 211 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to beginning. Together with the right to the grantee, her heirs and assigns in common with the grantors, their heirs and assigns to use a private alley 30 feet in width and 150 feet in length extending from Kelly Avenue, or Bramlett Road, over the Southern side of the property retained by the grantors and along a portion of the southern side of the above described lot, and also a 15 foot private alley along and over the property of the grantors, which alley runs along the southern side of the above described property.
