all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville City and Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On the east side of Summer street and known as Lot no. 3 of Block "A" in the subdivision of the property of The Melville Land Company, as shown by a plat recorded in the office of A. M. C. for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following dimensions and bounds to wit: Beginning at a point on the east side of Summer street one hundred and four and $\frac{7}{10}$ (104.75) feet from the Southeast corner of Summer and Burlington streets; thence with Summer street S. 16° 20' W. fifty-two and $\frac{3}{4}$ (52.75) feet to a point on Summer street; thence along the line of Lot No. 4 S. 71° 13' E. one hundred and ninety-four and $\frac{1}{4}$ (194.86) feet to a ten-foot alley; thence N. 16° 48' E.
