Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Part on a branch of North Saluda River and part on a branch of Mill Creek, waters of South Tyger River, and runs as follows: Beginning at a stone 3^y in the public Road which leads from the Buscombe Road near John St. Trammells to the Ridge Road near Cross plains Church and runs thence in a northerly direction with said Road to a stone 3^y in the road near house formerly occupied by J. B. Stewart, also corner of B. Cox's land; thence N. 34 E. 56 chains to a stone 3^y; also corner of said Burrell Cox; thence N. 66 W. 416.5 chains to a stone 3^y; thence N. 15 E. 7.70 to a spring 3^y; thence S. 74 E. nine chains to a stone 3^y; thence S. 43.2 E. 6.50 chains to a stone 3^y; thence S. 24 E. 9.80 chains to a poplar 3^y now dead and partly down and also corner of W. D. Southern and A. Burrell; thence S. 78 W. 7.50 chains to stone in the Road; thence with said Road and said Burrell's land to a stone 3^y in east road, corner of said Burrell's land; thence in a southeast direction with A.
