(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Greenville Trust Company, All the following described tracts of land:

① All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Gent Township, containing 91-2 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land as conveyed to Eva McHugh by D.P. Verner, Master, April 23, 1894, by deed recorded in deed book "AAA" page 766, and by her to me by deed dated June 5, 1920 recorded in deed book 48 page 370, reference to which deeds is hereby made, and bounded by lands now or formerly of T.T. McHugh, J.A. McHugh, M.E. Payne and others.

② All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, beginning at a stake on the road running by Welcome Church and running thence S. 89 E. crossing the road 10-70 to a stone 3x0m; S. 82-3/4 E. 3.25 to an iron pin; thence N. 23-3/4 E. 2.65 to P.A. x3m; thence N. 31 W. 1.84 to an iron pin; thence N. 42-1/2 E. 5.50 to an iron pin; thence N. 66 E. 8.10 to a stone 3x0m; thence N. 58 W. 12.12 to a sassafras; thence S. 77 W. 13.35 to a stone x3; thence S. 3-1/2 W. 4.50 to a stake x; thence 62 W. 13.20 to an iron pin x3 in the center of the road; thence S. 43-3/4 E. 5.75 to the bend in the road; thence S. 31 E. 2.27 to the bend; thence S. 15 W. 1.74 to the bend; thence S. 41-1/2 E. 1.22 to the beginning corner containing forty-one acres, more or less and being the same as conveyed to me by J.A. McHugh by deed dated March 22, 1920 recorded in deed book 48, page 245.

McHugh's line; thence N. 77 E. 2.00 to a sassafras; thence S. 38 E. 12.12 to a stone; thence S. 42-1 E. 22.20 to a stake; thence S. 71 E. 9.90 to an iron pin; thence S. 71-6/7 W. 7.0 to an iron pin on rock on Piedmont Road and right of way of the C. & G. Railway, thence N. 26-2 E. 7.87 to a stake thence N. 57 E. 4.30 to the beginning corner containing 57-1 acres, more or less, subject to right of way of P. & N.
