(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. Della R. Ellis, All that certain lot of land situated on Perry Avenue near the boundary line of the City of Greenville State and County aforesaid, known and designated as lot #5 on a plat showing the division of the Goldsmith-Cathryn property made by J. P. Lawrence July 25th 1907 and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on Perry Avenue at corner of lots #4 and #5, thence along Perry Ave N. 66-30 W. 56.5 feet to an iron pin corner of lots 5 and 6; thence along dividing line between lots 5 and 6, S. 23-30 W. 192.3 feet to an iron pin on a thirteen foot alley; thence with said alley S. 66-30 E. 56.5 feet to an iron pin corner lots 4 and 5; thence along dividing line of lots 4 and 5, N. 73-30 E. 192.3 feet to the beginning corner and is the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. heirs and assigns, against my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
