(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Working Benevolent State Grand Lodge of South Carolina, its successors and assigns,

"All that certain lot in City of Greenville, in Greenville County and State, beginning at a point on Broad street 50 feet from corner of Broad & Fall street, running thence S. 70° E. 50 feet, more or less to stake; thence N. 19° E. 75 feet to stake; thence N. 70° W. 50 feet more or less to stake; thence S. 19° W. 75 feet to the beginning corner being same lot conveyed to us by Pearl McVick, deed dated May 9th. 1919, recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 53 page 68.

Also, all that lot in said city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, beginning at corner of Broad and Fall street, running thence with Broad street 50 feet to stake corner of Lydia Bolinger lot, thence in a northerly direction with Bolinger's line 70 feet to A. Cooksey's line; thence in a westerly direction with A. Cooksey's line 50 feet to Fall street; thence with Fall street in a southerly direction 70 feet to beginning corner being same lot conveyed to us by B. H. Peacock and J. P. DeSoyer, deed dated May 9th. 1919, recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 53, page 67.

AND We ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Working Benevolent State Grand Lodge of South Carolina, its successors

heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
