(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. V. Queen All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about $\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Greenville Court House, near the Easley Bridge Road, known as lot no. 60 in plat of Highland subdivision of the J. M. Harris property recorded in Plat Book 6 page 146 said lot fronting 70 feet on the east side of Virginia Avenue and running back in parallel lines 130 feet to property of Jessie West being a portion of the same conveyed to me by Jessie Harris January 2, 1916, deed recorded in Book 37 page 454 subject however to the following terms and conditions which are conditions subsequent:
First. That the property is not to be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to persons of African descent.
Second. That no liquor, ardent spirits or near beer are to be sold on the property.
Third. That no house shall be built on the lot herein described to cost less than \$650 but any person may use two or more lots, placing one residence thereon.
Fourth. That no building shall be erected nearer the street than 10 feet from the street.
Fifth. That no use shall be made of the lots sold or any part thereof which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of the neighbouring lots.
Sixth. That the layout of the lots, shown on said plat shall be adhered to and no release of facing lots in any other direction than that shown on said plat shall be permitted.
Seventh. That the grantors receive the right to lay and place or authorize the laying and placing of electric or other street car tracks, sewer gas and water pipes, electric conduits or pipes, telegraph, telephone and electric light poles, or any other work or instruments of public utility, or in any way of the streets of said grantors without compensation to any lot owner.
In event of a violation by the purchasers of the first provision above the title to the lot shall revert to the grantors, except as against less creditors, and that in event of a violation of any of the other provisions above the grantor shall have the right to enforce the same by proper proceedings.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. V. Queen, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. V. Queen, his
