Mills, all my right title and interest, being an undivided one-half interest, in and to all that certain lot situate on the north side of West Washington street between Main and Laurens streets, in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, having a frontage of 22 feet on Washington St. and running back in parallel lines, a depth of 86 ft. more or less, bounded on the east by the Wallace Bldg. lot and on the west by the John A. Moore lot, and being the same lot described in the deed from A. D. L. Barksdale to me, conveying my said one-half interest dated August 14 1919, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 54, page 121. Subject, however, to the right of way or easement over the rear of said lot as created by the fourth clause of the will of Wm. A. Moore, deceased, and limited and described by said agreement in writing entered into by W. P. Childers, A. D. L. Barksdale and H. P. Mills. Subject, also, to the rights and easements reserved in said deed of A. D. L. Barksdale to me with reference to the stairway now located partly upon said property. Subject also to a mortgage for Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars given by Louise D. Union to J. F. Gallivan on February 9, 1916 recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 46 page 62 the grantee herein, as part of the considerations for this deed assuring all my liability on account of the debt secured by said mortgage.
