at and before the sealing of these presents by B. P. Edwards

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B. P. Edwards, All that certain piece, tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid in Water of Reedy River in Paris Mountain Township, about 6 1/2 miles west of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stone 300, near new bridge across Reedy River, the road leading to G. Peacock's Goodwill and running thence N. 32 1/2 W. 6.25 chains along line of said Peacock's Goodwill lands to stone 300, thence N. 36.63 W. 21.95 chains (still along Goodwill's line) to stone 300, thence S. 43 W. along line of lot of William T. Davis, Conveyed to G. W. Hawkins, 23.90 chains to stone 301, thence along line of lot of Jas. B. Davis (Conveyed to P. M. E. Martin) 8.39 E. 22.50 chains to stone 301 on said road, thence along said road to beginning corner and containing fifty land one-sixth acres more or less.

Referred to Deed Rec. # 1997 Vol. 6, p. 6, page 737 being the same piece of property deeded me by Mr. Davis on Dec. 27, 1918 recorded in Vol. 44 page 335.

As a part of the consideration for this deed the grantee herein assures and agrees to pay the principal of a two thousand dollar mortgage executed by P. O. Turner to L. O. Patterson, Atty. on May the 10th 1922 recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 31 page 149. All interest account of said mortgage to be paid by the grantee to Jas. B. Davis at which time the grantee is to pay off said note and mortgage.
