(3) The land herein conveyed shall be used only for residential purposes, and nothing shall be placed thereon which would constitute a nuisance or damage the adjoining lots or in any way make them undesirable for residential purposes.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee _____ hereinabove named, and

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.




