KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Meyers Arnold Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Thousand One Hundred (\$20,000.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Lewis A. Meyers and Noland Meyers

All that certain piece parcel of tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville Township Greenville County State of South Carolina about two and one-half (2 1/2) miles southeast of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and at short distances of Harris Road and being more particularly described according to a plat of the property of B. E. Geer prepared by R. E. Dalton, Engineer in March 1925 as follows: To wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Harris Road at the northeast corner of a five acre lot owned by L. W. Fariss on which is situated his barn and running thence with the center of Harris road and continuing beyond the end thereof as now laid out, S. 68-00-5 W. 74-8.8 feet to an iron pipe corner of lands of Thomas Ross, thence with the line of Ross' lands S. 38-40 E. 27.8 feet to a stake; thence still with the lines of the Ross lands S. 27-50 W. 610.5 feet to a white oak tree, thence with the line of Earle property S. 35-30 E. 206.5 feet to a stake; thence with the lines of Jenkinsons property N. 50-5 E. 124.7 feet to an iron pipe, thence still with the line of Jenkinsons property N. 50-43 E. 400 feet to an iron pipe corner of Martin property, thence with the line of Martin's property N. 41-10 W. 122.4 feet to an iron pipe, southeast corner of L. W. Fariss five (5) acre lot, thence N. 29-3 W. 430.6 feet to a stake in and near the center of road, thence still with the line of said road lot N. 28-44 E. 102 feet to the beginning corner containing fifty acres, 301.00 (50.30) acres more or less according to the survey of R. E. Dalton, Engineer. Less however, the several parcels of land annexed to 711ton St. Eagle, by deed recorded in vol. 83 page 452 office of the R. R. C. for Greenville County, S. C.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
