This rental contract and agreement made and executed by and between A. C. Cleveland, the lessor and J. P. Cothran Jr. and J. A. Putnam, the lessees, on the 27th day of February, 1919, all of parties being residents of the City of Greenville, S.C.

Witnesseth:

1. In consideration of the rental herein agreed upon, A. C. Cleveland agree to erect a building on the lot between Main and Jones Streets, fronting on College Street, in the City of Greenville, according to the plans and specifications heretofore agreed upon and to lease the same to the lessee \$1,000 for a period of five years for an annual rental of two thousand dollars, payable in equal monthly payments. The lessee hereby accepts this lease and agrees to pay regularly the said rental in equal monthly payments.

2. The payments of rent shall begin at the end of the month after the building is completed and turned over to the lessee for occupancy, the first payment being for the proportionate part of the month.

3. Distinction of the property by fire or other cause to such an extent as shall render the building unfit for occupancy shall terminate this lease unless the lessor desires to at once repair or rebuild the same, in which event payments of rent shall cease until the building is again ready for occupancy.

4. Failure to pay promptly the monthly rental shall render this lease void at the option of the lessor and in the event of Bankruptcy of the lessee this lease shall immediately become void.

5. Ordinary repairs caused by wear and tear of the property and not by negligence of the lessee or others shall be promptly made by the lessor.

To the faithful performance of the terms and conditions hereinafter contained, we bind ourselves, our heirs and assigns.
