(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Ernest S. Armstrong all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the waters of Rabun Creek containing 63 acres more or less, beginning at stake on Wilson Bridge Road and running thence N. 10° 2' W. 400 to stake, thence N. 68° 2' W. 5.25 to stake, thence N. 64° 2' W. 25.50 to stake, thence S. 32° W. 20.00 to stake, thence S. 60° E. 9.90 to stake, thence S. 19° W. 17.50 to Black Oak on Wilson Bridge Road, thence along said road to the beginning corner bounded by lands now or formerly owned by Jonathan Gary, William Gilbert, Mrs. C.
