KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. Lee Greene, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred

DOLLARS,

to him paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J. Eugene Carter

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. Eugene Carter his heirs and executors forever: All my right, title and interest in and to the following described tract, parcel and lot of land situated lying and being in the City and County of Greenville and in the State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances to wit:

Beginning at a point on Garlington Street (now known as Arlington Ave.) near side fifty (50) feet from corner of Garlington and MacLard Street and running thence along said Garlington Street N. 78-6 W. fifty (50) feet thence N. 18-50 E. One hundred and fifty (150) feet to lot of J. B. Rassar; thence along J. B. Rassar's back line parallel with Garlington Street (but 150. feet north thereof) for a distance of fifty (50) feet, to corner of lot of Mrs. J. E. Carter; thence along said Carter lot in a straight line for a distance of one hundred and fifty (150) feet to the beginning corner on Garlington Street and being the same lot of land conveyed to John C. Carter and J. Eugene Carter Trustees, by J. B. Rassar, by deed bearing date the 2nd day of October A.D. 1909, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the said County Book Vol. 5 at page 54.
