All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, fronting on Eagle Street and being known and designated as lot No. 5 of Block "A" on a plat showing a subdivision of the Mauldin-Eagle property said plat being recorded in Plat Book 8 at page 242, and described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a point on Eagle Street 142.0 feet from the intersection of Eagle Street and Mauldin street, and running thence N. 87-15 E. 150 feet to a stake on Alley, thence along said Alley N. 2-45 W. 70 feet to corner of lot No. 7, thence N. 87-15 W. 150 feet to a point on Eagle Street, corner of lot No. 7, thence along said Eagle Street S. 2-45 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
