E. corner of said road and running thence N. 15° 25' E. 125. feet in a stone, thence S. 60° 30' E. 245 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 60° 42' 1 foot to an iron pin, thence S. 17° 12' W. 981 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 28° 59' W. 2483 feet to the beginning
