(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the
 said V. M. Halecombe,
 All that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being
 in Austria Township, County of Greenville, and in the state of
 South Carolina, and is about one mile from Worcester Cotton
 Mills containing twenty-three acres more or less and having
 the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a maple 3x0m on Branch and running thence N.
 13° 48' E. 57' to a stone 3x0m; thence N. 67° 44' W. 9' 39" To a stone
 3x0m; thence S. 58° 12' W. 19' 32" to a stone in old road 3x0m; thence
 with old road S. 32° 34' E. 4' 16" to bend in road; thence S. 56° 14' E.
 3' 87" to branch; thence up the meanderings of said branch
 to the beginning corner. Said land being a part of that
 tract of land conveyed to B. P. King by Warren Shuler
 November 29th, 1913 and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for
 Greenville County in Vol. 23 page 470.
