(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the  
said George W. Clapp: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of  
land, and the boundary and status aforesaid, near the City  
of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kanawha"  
and situated on the south side of Oregon Street and  
contains one lot No. 4 of Block 13 in front of the said  
property recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County in  
Lot 18th "F" at page 66-67. The said lot has the  
following lines and boundaries: Beginning at a stake  
on the south side of said street 180 feet east of the  
corner of Mitchell Street and running thence along  
Oregon Street N. 63-30 E. Sixty feet to a stake at corner  
of Lot #5 in said block; thence along said lot E.  
26-30 E. One hundred and sixty-five feet to a stake at rear  
thence S. 63-30 W. Sixty feet to stake at corner of lot N. 3  
in said block; thence along said lot N. 26-30 W. one  
hundred and sixty-five feet to the beginning point on  
Oregon Street.
