D. Hardin the 29th day of December 1887 running thence N. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.12 chains to a stone 3¹ on the branch thence down the branch 4.15 chains to a black gum 3¹ thence N. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.19 chains to a stone 3¹ on the East side of the road thence along said road to the beginning, bound on all sides by lands of myself.
