(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said C. E. Barker, his heirs and assigns, the following described property, to wit:

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, in the County and Township of Greenville, just outside the City limits of Greenville, being a portion of Block "F" of the Buist property as shown by plat recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for said County and State in Plat Book "C", at page 10. (a strip 75 feet in width and approximately 418 feet in length on the north side of said Block "F" and included in Block "F" as shown on the plat above referred to, being now covered by the extension of Buist Avenue eastward to the line of H.M. Hester in the direction of Main Street), and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on the south side of Buist Avenue three hundred and fifteen (315) feet eastward from the east side of Tunnel Street (being 100 feet eastward from the fifteen foot alley shown on said plat, and being on the south west corner of the 75 foot strip of Block "F" now covered by said extension of Buist Avenue) and running thence S. 80° 56' along the said extension of Buist Avenue sixty (60) feet to a stake thence S. 9° 45' W.
