Wynne - All that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, State and County aforesaid on the White Horse Road known as Neills Road being a part of a one hundred and ninety and one-fourth acres of the real estate of the late James P. Wynne and set off to the said Henry P. Wynne in the division of said James P. Wynne's Estate and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on a large poplar and running thence N. 51 1/4 E. 12.00 chains to a stone road; thence N. 36 1/4 E. 8.30 to a stake; thence S. 51 1/4 W. 12.00 to a stone on edge of bottom, thence N. 36 1/4 W. 8.40 to the beginning, containing ten acres more or less. Also, see of that other tract of land situated on both sides of Peedey River, on the home place of the said James P. Wynne, and known as tract no. 5 in the division of the bottom land of the said James P.
