a corporation under the Laws of the State of South Carolina

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Greenville Realty and Investment Company, its successors and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Augusta Road about one-half mile from the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, containing three and 34/100 acres (less the tract hereinafter referred to) more or less, and described by metes and bounds, as:

Beginning at a stake "3X" on the North side of the Augusta Road, and running thence with the Augusta Road three and 60/100 chains to a stake "3X"; thence North 63 degrees east eleven and 30/100 chains to a stake "3X"; thence North 27 degrees West three and 30/100 chains to a stake "3X" on a twenty-foot road; thence along said road South 63 degrees West twelve and 57/100 chains to the point of beginning.
