(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Earle Duncan, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the state and County aforesaid in Chick Springs Township and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone on the north side of Chick Springs road, Lee Goodwin corner, and runs thence N. 16° 45' E. 72.1 chs to a stone Jane Johnson's corner, thence N. 73° 34' W. 4.14 chs to a stone N. m., thence S. 16° 34' W. 4.14 chs to a stone on Chick Springs road, thence with said road 4.20 chs to the beginning corner and containing three and one tenth (3 1/10) acres, more or less (Excepting and reserving twelve thousand square feet needed to A. M. Dillard). Beginning at a stone on the north side of Chick Springs road and running thence N. 17° E. 150 feet to an iron pin N. m.; thence S. 83° 2' E. 80 feet to a stone N. m. H. L. Riley corner, thence S. 17° W. 150 feet to Chick Springs road, thence with said road N. 83° 2' W. 80 feet to the beginning corner) and known as a portion of lot #14 in a survey made by J. N. Southern S. P. on the 6th day of August A.D. 1891.

(3x), thence N. 72° 45' W. 3.08 chs to a stone 3x, thence S. 17° 2' W. 12 chs to an iron pin; thence S. 17° 2' E. 2.08 chs to the beginning corner and containing two and forty-nine one hundredths (2 49/100) acres, more or less and bounded by lands of Bartley Hermans and others.
