the Evans Kelly land R. G. Foster Estate of William Wilkins, Estate of John
Foster, and the Estate of Richard Goodlett, and being the real estate passed
to the late John S. Foster and Richard Foster by the last Will and Testament
of Robert P. Foster. The said tract of land having at one time been owned by the
