Manning and R. M. Cleveland their heirs and assigns forever; all our right, title and interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County State of South Carolina.

In the City of Greenville, and lying on the west side of S. Main Street, and being described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of S. Main Street, and at the corner of an alley, and running thence with said alley N. 69.30 E. 110 feet to a cross alley; thence with said alley S. 20.30 W. 45.42 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 3 on plat herein-after referred to; thence with line of Lot #3 N. 69.30 E. 110 feet to an iron pin on Main Street; thence with Main St. N. 20.30 E. 45.42 feet to the beginning corner, return as Lots Nos. 1 and 2 on a plat of Mark Healthy Company, made by J. E. Derrine & Co. dated March, 26th, 1904.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the grantees herein, at the time of the execution and delivery of the original deed and in acceptance of this deed, do also assume and guarantee to pay the balance due upon a certain note and mortgage given by H. And in making this conveyance, it is distinctly understood and agreed that a certain note and mortgage given by W. M. Manning and R. M. Cleveland unto Jas. M. Richardson and H. B. Bates, February 1st, 1920, recorded in said R. M. C. Office, in Vol. 83, Page 73, is to remain open as it now is, and the balance due thereon is to be payable according to the terms and conditions of said mortgage.
