is hereby severally acknowledged), the said The Peoples National Bark of Greenville does hereby grant, bargain, sell, release and quitclaim unto the said A.C. Walker, his heirs and assigns, all its right, title and interest in and to the easement for light and air created by the two said deeds, to the end that said easement shall be extinquished.

And the said A.C. Walker, in lieu thereof, does hereby grant, bargain, release, sell and convey unto The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, as the owner of Lot #9 on the plat above referred to, an easement for light and air over a ten (10) foot rectangular strip on a portion of the eastern edge of Lot #10 on the plat above referred to, which strip is described as

Beginning at a point on the South side of the alley in the rear of lots #9 and #10, which Point is the Joint corner of said Lots, and munning thence along the Joint line of said lots in a southerly direction 59 feet more or less to a point 31 feet North of the building line on the North side of West Washington Street; thence a right angle end parallel with said building line, in a westerly direction, 10 feet to a point; thence a right angle and parallel with the joint line of lots #9 and #10, in a northerly direction 59 feet, more or less to a point in the southern side of the said alley; thence with the rear line of lot #10 along the edge of said alley, in an easterly direction, 10 feet to the point of beginning; provided, however, that said easement shall not commence on the ground, but on a horizontal line fourteen feet and six inches (14' 6") above the ground, measuring from a point on the inside edge of the paved sidewalk on the West side of Laurens Street, which point is twenty-five feet and six inches (25' 6") South of the northeast corner of Lot #8; provided, however, that the granting of this easement shall not operate to prevent (and such right is expressly reserved) A.C. Walker, his heirs and assigns, as the owner of Lot #10, from erecting and always maintaining skylights on the roof of any building occupying said strip above the fourteen foot and six inch line, but said skylight shall not be placed within three (3) feet of the west wall of any building erected on Lot #9 nor be more than three (3) feet high; and provided, further, that in the event the said A.C. Walker shall not erect a five story building on his said Lots #10, #11 and #12 within one year after the date of this instrument; the easement for light and air above conveyed shall be extended so as to include the entire length of said ten foot strip (that is, from the alley in the rear to West Washington Street) on the eastern edge of Lot #10; instead of merely the northern portion thereof as above described and conveyed.

To have and to hold unto the said The Peoples National Bark of Greenville, its successors and assigns, forever.

And the said A.C. Walker does hereby agree to pay to The Peoples National Bank of Greenville so much of the cost of erecting the west wall of its proposed building as may be due to the fact that the said A.C. Walker will locate his cellar on the front portion of his lot #10, the emount of such additional cost to be determined by the architects now employed by the parties in connection with the erection of said proposed buildings, and said sum is to be paid promptly when determined by them.

And the said A.C. Walker does further agree that the entire east wall of his proposed building above the line where said wall leaves The Peoples National Bank building and for a distance -
