State of South Carolina, County of Greenville.

This Agreement made between John IcSween, hereinafter referred to as Lessor, and James B.-League, hereinafter referred to as Lessee: Vitnesseth:-

That the Lessor has leased and demised unto the Lessee, that certain lot of land belonging to the Lessor, situate on the west side of North Isin Street, measuring approximately twenty (20) feet on North Isin Street, by one hundred thirty (130) feet deep, and bounded on the north by lot of W.H. Keith; on the East by North Main Street; on the South by lot of Cleveland and Haynsworth, and on the west by an alley; on which lot there is located a two story brick store building, for the full term of five (5) years, beginning on November 15th, 1925, and ending on November 15th, 1930, at the rental of three hundred (300.00) Dollars per month, payable on the first day of each month.

And the Lessor does further give and grant unto the Lessee, the right and option to renew said lease for the full term of two (2) years, beginning November 15th, 1930, at the rental of Four Hundred (400.00) Dollars per nonth, payable nonthly on the first day of each month, provided the lessee shall, on or before Lay 15th, 1930, give notice in writing to the Lessor, of his purpose to claim said extension, and shall agree in said writing to pay the increased rents as herein provided. In case of failure to give such written notice, then this lease is to terminate on Hovember 15th, 1930.

The Lessee agrees to accept the building, including elevator and all fixtures, in their present condition, and agrees to pay the rentals as herein provided, and on the termination of this lease, he is to surrender the premises in as good condition as they now are, reasonable wear and tear excepted. (Hearing rooms and light fixtures belong to Lesses and are not included herein).

It is a condition of this lesse that it shall not be assigned, nor the premises sublet, without the consent of the Lessor in writing.

The Lessee is to keep said premises, including all fixtures, in good condition, and is to pay for any needed repairs to the interior of said building. The Lessor agrees to maintain the exterior of said building and the roof in good condition. Provided, however, that the Lessor shall not be bound to make any said repairs unless and until the Lessee shall give written notice of the necessity therefor.

In case of the total destruction of said building by fire, the Lessee shall be released from the payment of any rents until and unless the said building is restored. In case of partial destruction by fire, the rents shall be abated in proportion to the amount of damages suffered by said building, and until said building shell be restored, when the full amount of said rents shall become payable as herein stipulated.

Should there be default in the payment of any monthly rental for a period of thirty days, the Lessor shall have the right to cancel this lesse and rateke the premises, but this shall in no way impair his renedy for past due rents.
