whereas, it was never the purpose of this corporation in any of said deeds to create a condition subsequent, the violation of which would operate a forfeiture or reversion of the property; it being the sole intention of this corporation that the conditions were in the way of building restrictions for the benefit of all lot owners, as shown on said plat.
