I now all men by these presents that I, R.O. Patterson, as executor of the will of H.C. Markley, deceased, and as the legal owner and holder of a note executed by James F. Green to the said H.C. Markley, dated April 10, 1916, for twenty-four hundred dollars and of a mortgage given to secure the payment of said note and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State in Mortgage Book 44, at page 162, do hereby, for value received, release from the lien of said mortgage that lot of land conveyed by the said J.F. Green to W.L.
